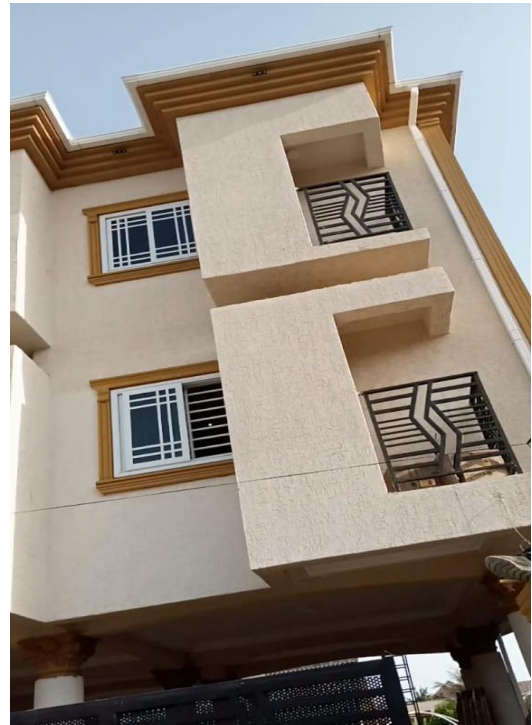


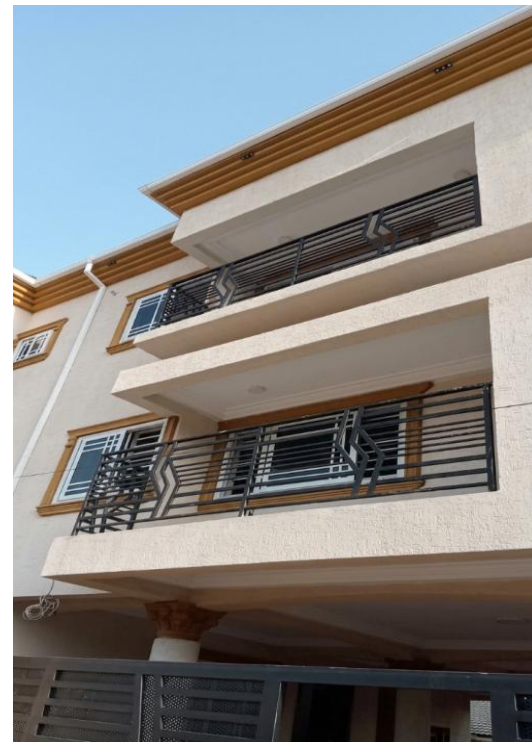
SECTION B — FINISHED PROJECT

KNX FULL BUILDING CONSTRUCTION. FINISHED PROJECT.

Building a house from start to finish involves a systematic, multi-stage process: site preparation, structure and foundation, framing, structural work, plumbing/electrical "roughings" and finally, interior/exterior finishes like painting.



It begins with excavation and setting footers, then to building walls (masonry or framing), roofing, installing utilities, and finishes with flooring and decoration.



At KNX we believe that a strong foundation is a strong house. We select appropriate materials from the foundation to the structure and finishes based on the design and site condition.



At KNX we also ensure regular inspections of structural components and utilities to comply with building codes.

- **Inspections** — this is very crucial at each stage of the construction i.e foundation, framing and electrical



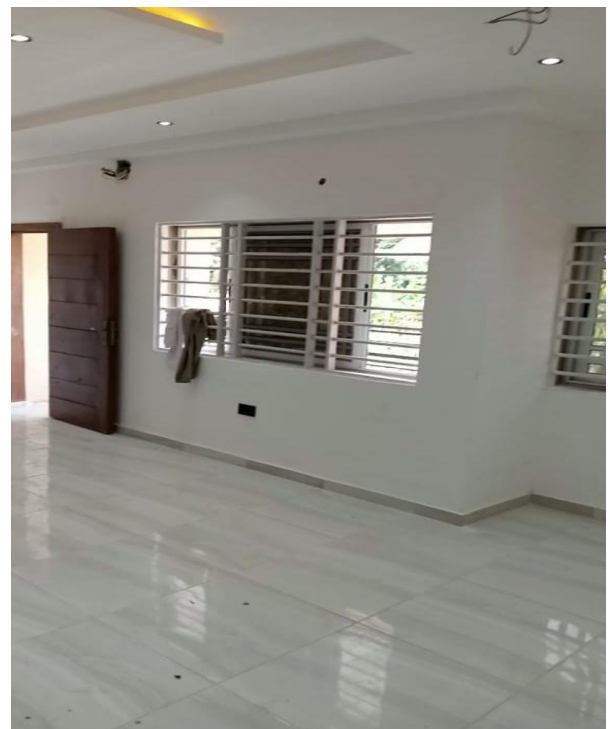
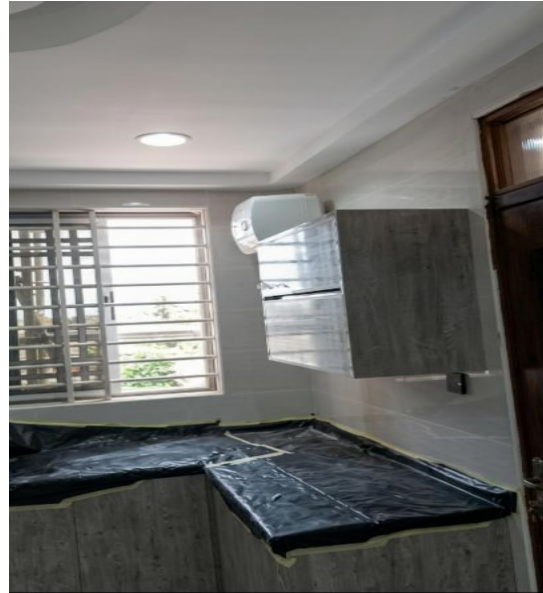
This is because any mistake done at these stages will seriously affect the time and funds designated for the project and if overlooked might in the future cause bigger damage.

- **Supervision** — we have skilled Contractors who are always available to ensure that the structural stability and accurate layout of the building is met.

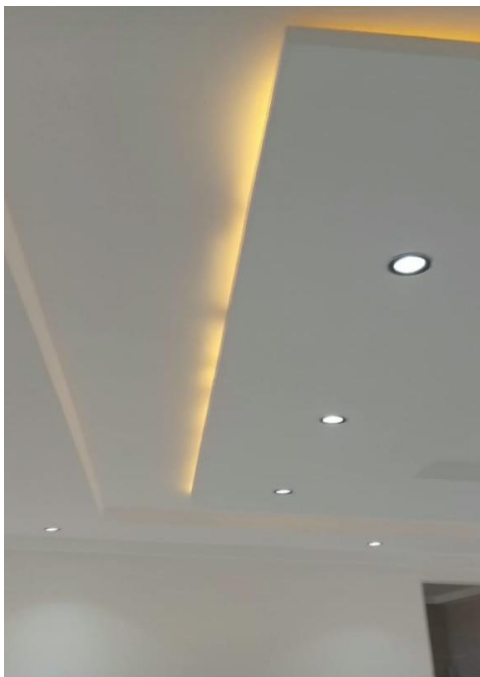


KNX INTERIOR FINISHES AND CONSTRUCTION

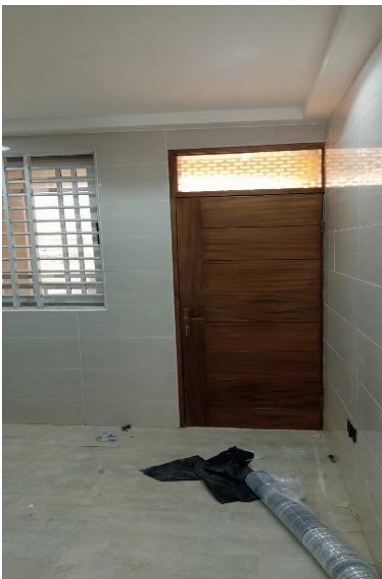
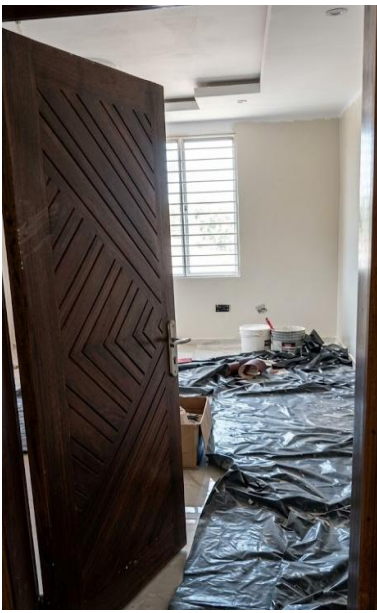
At our company we make sure the money you spent is worth it. We believe that the interior part of the building defines the drastic mindset of the architect and the engineers.
